#### 1753 Apologies for absence

**RESOLVED** to accept the following apologies for absence: Cllr P. Roberts – attending Olympics Cllr J. Knight – transport difficulty

#### 1754 Interests

There were no declarations of interest.

Noted that four councillors had attended Code of Conduct training, either by SALC or Mendip DC

## 1755 Minutes

**RESOLVED** that the minutes of the PC meeting of 11 July 2012 be accepted as a true record. They were signed by the chairman.

## 1757 Planning

The following decision by Mendip DC was noted.

2011/1538 Haywood Farm, Terry Hill, Radstock BA3 5UF. Erection of a new cattle barn and associated alterations. Full Planning Permission. Approved.

## 1758 Mendip Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment

**RESOLVED** to approve the draft letter explaining the purpose and detail of Mendip's future housing needs document. A number of councillors and members of the public offered to distribute the letter, which is to go to all households in the parish.

#### 1759 Allotments

• The allotments had been topped and would be done again in September

- The possibility of lottery funding for a ride-on mower was being investigated
- Concern was expressed that the allotments might be getting funding at the expense of other projects (Cllr Drewe said that grants for two thirds of the cost of new heating for Faulkland Village Hall has been won).
- The trench for the allotment water supply would be dug the next weekend
