

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Faulkland Action to Slow Speeding Traffic Group (FASST Group)

What are we trying to achieve?

(suggested outcomes)

- All residents in the village feel safe to walk along pavements and cross the road.
- 95% of the traffic through the village is driving at the correct speed.
- There is a 20mph limit through the village.

Membership

- A membership of up to five people to include at least one parish councillor and two representatives from the Faulkland Community SpeedWatch Group.
- Quorum will be three members including the Chair of the Group.

Meetings

- The group will meet as and when required.

Delegated Powers

- None

Purpose

- To research and understand the current and future traffic issues for the village, including reviewing data from CSW sessions and AutoSpeedWatch on a regular basis.
- To collate and analyse parishioner feedback on traffic issues within the village.
- To liaise with the Parish Council on traffic issues providing support and advice as needed. This could include formulating proposals on traffic calming options and highway improvements, with due regard to planning criteria and existing commitments for the Parish Council for to consider and approve.
- To liaise with TAG, Mendip CSW group, Avon and Somerset Police as required.
- To research potential funding streams and other support for traffic calming projects.

Scope

- The initial scope of the group will be Faulkland village but this could be widened to include the parish at a later date if this is supported by the Parish Council.

Reporting

- To provide updates on progress on a quarterly basis to the Parish Council and reports as required.

Communications

- To inform parishioners on progress and updates via Parish News, Facebook and village noticeboards
- To provide updates on the Parish Council website where required
